# **U.S. ADDRESS**

### Have You Moved?

The U.S. government requires that F-1 & J-1 students report any residential address change. If you've changed your residence address since last quarter it is time to update your <u>ISS Portal</u> with your U.S. Local Address. Please take a moment to log in

- Click on 'Personal Information'
- Click on 'U.S. Address (Update within 10 Days of Any Changes)'
- Make any updates to your Local Address
- Click **'Save'** at the bottom of page

# Full-Time (12 Credits Units) Registrations Requirements Reminder

This is a reminder that international students are required by the U.S. government to enroll in 12 course units (CUs) each quarter (Winter, Spring, & Fall) unless it is your final, graduating quarter. If you are in your final, graduating quarter you will need to let the ISS know by completing the <u>Reduced Course Load</u> requests and send it to <u>internationalstudents@ucr.edu</u>

• F and J students can only take one online course. All other classes must be in-person.

## Undergraduate F students only

• If Fall 2024 will be your last quarter and you will be below 12 units, or if you are an F-2 student and will be taking 10 units or less, you must submit a reduced course load form to our office by Monday, Tuesday October 7 at 12pm (noon). This will give us time to initiate a reduced tuition must be routed to the registrar's office by noon on <u>October 11, 2024</u>
