If you do decide to travel, please ensure that you have all your travel documents in order; including a recent travel signature on your DS-2019/I-20 Form.


CAMPUS CLOSURE

UPDATE RESIDENTIAL ADDRESS

U.S. Address | Have You Moved?

The U.S. government requires that F-1 & J-1 students report any residential address change within 10 days of moving. If you've changed your residence address, it is time to update your ISS Portal with your U.S. Local Address. Please take a moment to log in

- Click on 'Personal Information'
- Click on 'U.S. Address (Update within 10 Days of Any Changes)'
 - o Make any updates to your Local Address

Click "Save" at the bottom of the page.

Post-Completion OPT

If you have just completed your academic program in Spring 2025, Congratulations! For F-1 students, please remember that you are eligible to apply for Post-Completion OPT up to 60-days after your program end date. Learn how to get started with your Post-Completion OPT application.

Program Extension

Don't forget to check your I-20/DS-2019 end date. If you need more time to complete your degree, you need to apply for a program extension before your current I-20 or DS-2019 form expires.


